Also, as required every 3 to 5 years, lime was added to the Towne Lake ponds to maintain the correct “PH” balance, which enhances the fishing in these ponds.

## **Architectural Review Committee News**

Many of you continue to make wonderful improvements and complete timely maintenance on your homes, which reflects the high-class of our Towne Lake neighborhood and its residents. Even better, most are submitting ARC requests before doing the work or before making improvements like house additions or turning the car port into a garage. However, we continue to have homeowners make modifications or repairs, such as replacing windows, repainting, or adding pergolas, without approval. This creates a problem for the ARC and may create a big problem for that homeowner if the repair made does not comply with the standards set forth in the covenants. We have actually had a few instances over the past six months where homeowners that did not ask for approval beforehand were later required to modify their improvements to comply with HOA/ARC guidelines after the fact. This is an undesirable situation for all parties; therefore, please ensure that you submit your request before starting any work to avoid the \$50 ARC fine and any hassle with after-the-fact modifications. The average turnaround on an ARC request is roughly 24 hours, and most are approved with little or no questions asked. **Streets, Sidewalks, and Trash Collection**

Towne Lake has needed very few repairs to our streets and sidewalks this year and we hope that will continue. Please continue to report problems with streets and sidewalks the City of Montgomery Maintenance Department or to any Board member. Street/sidewalk maintenance can be requested by calling 311 or 334-240-INFO (4636). Hours of operation are Monday through Friday, 6:00 am to 3:30 pm. You may also e-mail your request to [311@montgomeryal.gov](mailto:311@montgomeryal.gov) . Regarding garbage and trash, please remember that the City of Montgomery observes a holiday schedule for the following holiday weeks for the remainder of this year: Independence Day (July 4<sup>th</sup>), Labor Day (September 5<sup>th</sup>), Columbus Day (October 10<sup>th</sup>), Veteran’s Day (November 11<sup>th</sup>), Thanksgiving (November 24<sup>th</sup>), and Christmas (observed December 26<sup>th</sup>). During these weeks, our garbage bins will be collected on Tuesday and Friday, and bulk trash is collected “as time permits,” which means it usually doesn’t happen on these weeks. You can always find an updated schedule at the City website under Departments→Sanitation.

**Grounds and Irrigation**

There have been no major grounds or irrigation concerns over the past few months. However, you may notice that we removed the shrubs along the brick wall on Technacenter and have since installed sod. We have been satisfied with the service that we are receiving from Central Alabama Landcare, who maintains our common grounds. They are responsible for grounds maintenance including mowing, trimming shrubbery, and planting flowers at all of the entrances to Towne Lake. Although we’ve replaced a few sprinkler heads, the irrigation system has been generally working effectively and is ready for the summer. If you have any suggestions or notice any problems with the common grounds in our subdivision, please do not hesitate to call one of the board members or bring up your concerns at the general meeting. Thank you for doing such a great job to maintain your own yards – together, we make Towne Lake look great!
